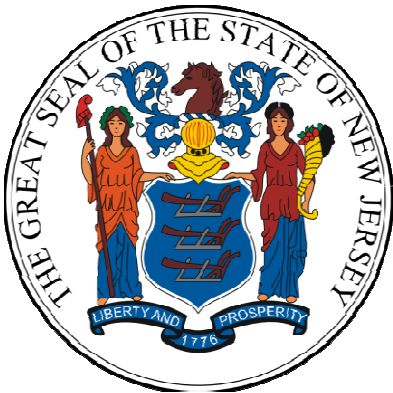

## **No Bake Homemade Horse Treats**



### **Honey Cookies**

- 1/4 cup dry oatmeal
- 1 cup sweet feed
- 2 Tlbs. Apple sauce
- 1 Tlbs. Honey (or molasses)
- 1 cup cheerios
- 1/2 cup water

Mix oatmeal with water. Add sweet feed and apple sauce. Mix well. Stir in remaining ingredients. Shape and serve.

### **Pony Pizza**

- Plain Rice Cakes
- Apple Sauce
- Any topping your heart desires.

Spread apple sauce on one side of rice cake. Top with things like grated carrots, grated apples, sweet feed, crushed peppermints, watermelon, or whatever your horse loves.

### **Fruit Surprise**

- 2 cups horse feed
- 1 banana - chopped
- 1 apple - diced
- 6 strawberries - sliced
- 4 baby carrots - sliced
- 4 peppermints - crushed

Mix all ingredients together and serve. Your horse will love you for it.
